UNITED CYCLE **Scholarship Criteria**

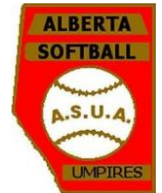


The United Cycle Scholarship shall be awarded to one male and one female affiliated member of Softball Alberta.

In order for your application to be processed and eligible, the following must be provided:

- Application Form
- Proof of attendance or enrollment at a post-secondary educational institution
- A brief, one-page **list** of their competitive softball involvement and achievements (include current and all previous years). Be sure to include any Provincial or Post-Provincial tournaments, Alberta Summer Games, Western Canada Games, Canada Summer Games that you have attended along with any personal awards you have received.
- Two letters of reference, preferably from individuals directly involved with the applicant in the sport of softball

UMPIRE MEMORIAL **Scholarship Criteria**



The Umpire Memorial Scholarship shall be awarded to an affiliated member of the Alberta Softball Umpires Association (ASUA) or can be a son or daughter of a registered umpire.

In order for your application to be processed and eligible, the following must be provided:

- Application Form
- Proof of attendance or enrollment at a post-secondary educational institution
- Applicant must have attended the Minor Umpires' Camp, or have umpired at some level of Softball in Alberta, or must be the son or daughter of an umpire who has been registered for five (5) consecutive years with the ASUA.
- A brief essay displaying a positive attitude toward softball titled either
 - o "What The Sport Of Softball Has Done For Me", or
 - o "How My Parent(s)' Influence Has Helped In The Development of Softball In Our Area"
- Two letters of reference, preferably from individuals directly involved with the applicant in the sport of softball



MEMORIAL Scholarship Criteria

Three (3) Memorial Scholarships shall be awarded to affiliated members who are currently playing softball, conducting or assisting in instructional clinics, coaching, or umpiring.

In order for your application to be processed and eligible, the following must be provided:

- Application Form
- Proof of attendance or enrollment at a post-secondary educational institution
- Write a brief essay displaying a positive attitude toward softball titled "What the Sport of Softball Has Done for Me" within that essay include a description of "What YOU have given back to the game of Softball" (let us know if you are conducting or assisting in instructional clinics, coaching, umpiring, or training and for how many years you have done so).
- Two letters of reference, preferably from individuals directly involved with the applicant in the sport of softball

BOARD of DIRECTORS Scholarship Criteria



The Board of Directors Scholarship shall be awarded to an applicant who is family of an individual who is presently on the Executive or Board of Directors of any Softball Alberta affiliated league, association, or organization.

In order for your application to be processed and eligible, the following must be provided:

- Application Form
- Proof of attendance or enrollment at a post-secondary educational institution
- A brief essay displaying a positive attitude toward softball titled "How My Family's Influence Has Assisted in the Development of Softball in Our Area."
- Two letters of reference, preferably from individuals directly involved with the applicant in the sport of softball

LEADERS

Scholarship Criteria



Two (2) Softball Alberta “Leaders” Scholarships shall be awarded to one affiliated member currently involved in the development of softball at the local or provincial level. Assisting or conducting instructional clinics, being involved in coaching or softball training.

In order for your application to be processed and eligible, the following must be provided:

- Application Form
- Proof of attendance or enrollment at a post-secondary educational institution
- A **list** that includes your volunteerism with softball (provide a detailed description including number of specific programs, camps, clinics, teams that you have been involved with in the past and present). .
- Write a brief essay titled “What I Have Done for the Sport of Softball”. Your essay should display why you feel it is important that you give back to the sport.
- Two letters of reference, preferably from individuals directly involved with the applicant in the programs you are involved in

The selection of the Scholarship recipients will be made at the Softball Alberta September Board Meeting, and the scholarships will be presented locally to the recipients in September or October.

The amount of the Scholarship shall be determined annually by the Board of Directors, and shall not be less than \$750.

Successful applicants will be asked for a SIN number before receiving their scholarship cheque.
