



The following changes are to take effect immediately and will remain in place until in person learning resumes in Calgary, Fort McMurray and now Edmonton.

All youth indoor sport and recreation activities that are not part of a school program are not permitted for **grade 7 to 12 youth** in the municipalities of Calgary and Fort McMurray, effective April 20, and the municipality of Edmonton, effective April 22. This includes homeschooled students.

This means if you are enrolled in Grades 7-12 and live in Calgary, Fort McMurray or Edmonton, you cannot participate in softball group training indoors until in-person learning resumes.

Outdoor sport and recreation activities and 1-on-1 indoor training with a trainer or coach are still permitted.

Indoor activities may be moved outdoors, provided all safety requirements for outdoor physical activities are followed.
